



VOTER REGISTRATION

To be eligible to vote in the next election in West Virginia, you must be registered to vote at least 30 days before the election date. You can register to vote through the County Board of Elections in person or by mail. You can register online.

You may also register to vote at your local WV DMV office when you go in for any driver's license/ID card transactions, including: applying for a new driver's license; renewals, and changing your name or address.

You will need to complete and submit a Voter Registration and Information Update Form.

To register to vote **in person** or **by mail**, take or send a completed Voter Registration and Information Update Form to your local County Board of Elections office.

You can pick up a copy of the form at any:

1. Boards of Elections Office.
2. WV DMV deputy registrar office.
3. WV public library.
4. County Treasurer Office.
