### Allied Health MAA Diploma Step-Up Scholarship

**Deadline – September 23, 2019**

The Allied Health MAA Diploma Step-Up Scholarship is intended for qualified graduates, from the Valley College Medical Administrative Assistant (MAA) diploma program, who enroll in the Valley College Business Administration or Health Services Administration Associate of Applied Business degree programs or the Valley College Business Administration or Health Services Administration Bachelor of Science programs offered online. This scholarship is designed to encourage the graduate to further their education and develop additional technical, communication, and managerial skills that can lead to more employment opportunities. The applicant is considered a candidate for the scholarship during his or her enrollment in the Associate or Bachelor degree program.

#### **Timing of award and award amount is as follows:**

- **Business Administration:** This scholarship is a no debt scholarship meaning that the award will consist of the cost of the program, books, and fees minus any grants (federal or state) received by the student. The scholarship has no cash equivalency and will not be applied to any previous balance that the student may have with Valley College.
- **Health Services Administration:** This scholarship is a no debt scholarship meaning that the award will consist of the cost of the program, books, and fees minus any grants (federal or state) received by the student. The scholarship has no cash equivalency and will not be applied to any previous balance that the student may have with Valley College.

#### **Terms and Conditions:**

1. Enrollment in the Valley College Business Administration or Health Services Administration AAB or Bachelor degree program offered online during the period of August 1st, 2019 to September 24, 2019.
2. Must have started the MAA Diploma program between the periods of March 1, 2017 to February 28, 2018 and graduated from that program at Valley College during the period of September 27, 2017 to December 4, 2018.
3. Complete the scholarship application including an essay question by the September 23, 2019 deadline.
4. This scholarship cannot be combined with any other Valley College scholarships.
5. Failure to complete/graduate from the degree program for any reason will lead to forfeiture of the scholarship award.

#### Application Procedure:

1. Meet with the Financial Aid office to discuss financing options including completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and any additional required documents.
2. The prospective students may obtain a scholarship application from the Valley College Financial Aid office during the admissions process.
3. Complete the Scholarship Application which includes an essay question. All information requested on the application must be complete and legible. The application must be signed by the applicant.

#### Submission Procedure

The completed Scholarship Application must be submitted to the Financial Aid Department. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted. The Financial Aid Advisor will forward all completed applications to the Campus Director. Even though the Online programs are administrated through the Martinsburg campus, the Campus Director at the enrolling campus will review the scholarship application and recommend the applicant for the scholarship award. The Director of Financial Aid will grant the final approval.
